

# Helping Our Community Stay Safe and Supported

As wildfires continue to devastate Los Angeles County our thoughts are with everyone affected by this crisis. Many are facing the loss of homes, disruptions to their daily lives, and the uncertainty that comes with such a situation. We are all united in the shared pain of this moment and would like to provide available resources to assist you.

Apply for FEMA Assistance: Individuals and families in affected areas may be eligible to receive money for essential items like food, water, baby formula, and other emergency supplies, in addition to money to help with housing needs. Once individuals have filed a claim with their insurance provider, the next step in starting their recovery process is to apply for FEMA assistance.

- <u>DisasterAssistance.gov</u>: Easiest, fastest, and most convenient way to apply for individuals with access to the internet and powered electronic devices.
- **<u>FEMA App</u>**: For mobile devices.
- FEMA Helpline: 1 (800) 621-3362.
- **Disaster Recovery Centers:** At these centers <u>located</u> in LA County, individuals and business owners can apply for federal aid and access a range of support services from local, state, and nonprofit organizations.
- Housing Relief: Impacted residents who have been forced to evacuate or displaced from their homes can find <u>local shelter information</u> for LA County.
- Job Loss Assistance: For individuals who lost their job due to the wildfires, <u>benefits</u> through the State of California are available.
- LA County Recovers: This <u>website</u> includes a range of resources, services, and information for residents and businesses affected by LA County wildfires.
- Insurance Guidance: The California Department of Insurance has taken action to protect individuals impacted by wildfires.
  - For tips and information on preparing and navigating insurance claims, the California Department of Insurance provides valuable <u>resources</u> to consumers.
  - Hotline: Residents can call for additional information at 1 (800) 927-4357.
- Small Business Assistance: <u>Assistance</u> is available for small businesses in need in the region, including low-interest disaster loans.
- Tax Extensions and Relief : Individuals in affected areas may be eligible for extensions on filing and tax relief due to damaged or destroyed property.
  - The IRS has announced a deadline extension for individuals and businesses affected by these wildfires until Oct. 15, 2025, to file various individual and business tax returns and make tax payments. See the <u>full list</u> of extensions, respective deadlines, and more disaster-related information.
